

## Author Guidelines for submitting your articles to PSG Journal of Translational and Clinical Research

### Presentation and format

- Double spacing
  - Margin 2.5 cm from the four sides
  - Page number should be given properly
  - Times new roman format should be used to write the manuscript
  - Headings should be 14 and bold, capital letters
  - The data should be 12
  - The reference should be cited
  - Language should be English
  - Write the full term for each abbreviation at its first use in title, abstract, keywords and text separately unless it is a standard unit of measure.
  - Line spacing 1.5cm

- All submissions should be accompanied with a cover page which includes the title of the article and the author details and contact information.
  - We intend to follow the uniform guidelines specified by the ICMJE. Please follow the link for instructions on preparing your manuscript.(

  - Please acknowledge the funding source (e.g. PSG PRIME, Dr Thangavelu grant, ICMR etc.,) in your manuscript. If you have received funds from a commercial agency such as a pharmaceutical company disclose conflict of interest.

  - We strongly encourage you to use a plagiarism checker before your submit your article. There are several online plagiarism checkers available. (e.g. <https://www.duplichecker.com/>)
  - Please submit a copy of the Institutional Human / Animal ethics approval copy with your submissions.
  - A copyright form signed by all authors should be submitted with the article. This can be downloaded separately from [psgimsr.ac.in](http://psgimsr.ac.in)

  - No manuscript with personal identifiers/photographs without masking the identity will be accepted.
