Population Pharmacokinetics Data Analysis and Visualization

This workshop runs for three days with dedicated time for introduction and hands on with R software package for data processing and data visualization. Programming in R is considered as an important requirement in the field of Pharmacometrics, therefore this section has been introduced since last year. Day two and three will focus on introduction to the concepts of population pharmacokinetic and pharmacodynamics models and hands-on exercises with NONMEM software package. The software will be provided in flash-drives for the participants to work during the workshop.
