DRESS CODE FOR MALE STUDENTS:

	Allowed	Not allowed
Dress	Formal white pant – regular fit. Formal white shirt (half-sleeve)	Printed shirts, T-shirts, garments made of denim or corduroy, three-fourth sleeve shirts, sleeveless shirts, opened first button of the shirt etc
Grooming	Well-groomed hair on the head Neatly shaven face.	French crop, braided hair, ponytail, hair clips/bands
Footwear	Black shoes with fastening or without fastening (cut shoes) White / Black socks	Sports shoes, boots, slippers, sandals etc
Accessories		Bracelets, rings, chains
Apron	Half-sleeved white apron with college logo	Full-sleeved aprons, aprons without logo

DRESS CODE FOR FEMALE STUDENTS:

	Allowed	Not allowed
Dress	Formal Kurta and churidar of the prescribed color. If a dupatta is worn, it should be pinned.	Pants, shorts, leggings, jeggings, sleeveless tops, T-shirts, garments made of denim or corduroy, etc Pallus of Sarees and Dupattas should not be flowing.
Grooming	Well-groomed hair	Loose hair, flowers, long nails, striking Mehendi, etc
Footwear	Black, Cut shoes	Sports shoes, boots, slippers, etc
Accessories	One or two bangles Anklet without bell	Anklet with bell
Apron	Half-sleeved white apron with college logo	Full-sleeved aprons, aprons without logo

PLEASE NOTE:

- During the first year, until the uniforms are worn, students can come in color dress with specs as mentioned above.
- During non-scholastic occasions, when the students are permitted to wear a colour dress, dresses such as shorts, torn jeans, ripped jeans, patch-work jeans, sleeveless shirts / tops, slit tops without bottoms, ill-fitting jeggings or leggings etc should not be worn.
